Please find attached our manuscript for comment entitled "Software tools to facilitate systematic review used for cancer hazard identification" to be submitted as a brief communication to Environmental Health Perspectives. I have already been in contact with the Editor-in-Chief, Sally Darney. This is the correct version of the manuscript that should be reviewed.

Authorship for this paper has been restricted to persons who made significant contributions to the design or implementation of these tools at IARC/NTP.

3. 1st week of February – submission of manuscript to EHP.
