2. all electronic correspondence, whether email, SMS, text, direct message or other instant message, Signal, WhatsApp, Telegram or otherwise, which was sent to or from (including copying, whether as cc: or bcc:) Ryan Sriver, was sent or received at any time from June 1, 2019 through May 31, 2020, inclusive, and which includes one or more of the following, anywhere, whether in a Subject field, body of an email, or attachment: i) ClimateFeedback (whether as part of e.g., a url, such as <https://climatefeedback.org>, or otherwise), ii) "Climate Feedback" (quotations merely delineate the search term), iii) Lomborg, iv) Koonin, and/or v) Shellenberger; and
3. all electronic correspondence, whether email, SMS, text, direct message or other instant message, Signal, WhatsApp, Telegram or otherwise, which was sent to or from (including copying, whether as cc: or bcc:) Ryan Sriver, was sent or received at any time from June 1, 2019 through May 31, 2020, inclusive, and was also sent to, from, or copying, whether cc: or bcc:, Emmanuel Vincent. We request entire "threads" of which any responsive electronic correspondence

Information responsive to your request is available and attached. These are public documents numbering 95 pages.

You have a right, under the law, to seek a review of this response by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) in the Office of the Attorney General.
