Hi Jessica:

Thanks again for your time last week, and thanks for the below info. We were brainstorming a little internally and I wanted to run an idea by you for initial reaction. One of the staffing challenges we are having here is being able to hire, within the constraints of the Civil Service system, economists with econometrics experience, so this program could be a great way to bring in someone with experience given that they would be paid by NYU. I think hiring an economist would fit within your program's requirement that the fellow advance affordable, reliable, clean energy, as our economists play a critical role in implementing our carbon reduction and distributed energy resources goals, and affordability is a key component of their analysis.

Does this sound like a reasonable idea worth pursuing? I recognize that we need to share more information through the application process, but I just wanted to make sure this idea was not off base.
