Hi, Jessica. Great to touch base with you on Monday! Once again, thank you for taking the time to meet with us. More important, thank you for all the amazing work you and your colleagues are doing to extend health coverage and promote health equity, including recent strong statements about the impact of Speaker McCarthy's Medicaid proposals.

As promised, this note follows up some of the points we discussed on Monday.

An emerging challenge in unwinding involves beneficiaries having nowhere to go for help when problems arise.

Assistance is needed, for example, when a family gets a notice it doesn't understand, or a parent takes their child to the doctor and learns Medicaid has been terminated. If such families do not get hands-on help, procedural termination often results. On Monday, we recommended three approaches to giving more families a place to go for help, especially in historically marginalized communities:

- 1. The Administration should maximize funding that helps community agencies provide one-on-one help. We appreciate HRSA's supplemental funding for health centers. And CCIIO's additional funding for navigators could also be helpful, if navigators can use the money to help people obtain a Medicaid eligibility determination. That role has a nexus to the Marketplace, since a person's movement from Medicaid to Marketplace requires a determination of Medicaid ineligibility, which does not happen when Medicaid ends for procedural reasons.
- 2. Mitigation plans should have states place procedural terminations on hold if families attempting telephonic renewal face prolonged call-center delays. OCR noted that, "under some circumstances," a state may violate civil rights laws by failing to "adequately fund and staff call centers to ensure they are accessible without prolonged delays." OCR explained, "Persons of color are less likely to have broadband or internet access, or transportation or jobs that permit the time and access needed to meet with Medicaid enrollment staff in person, and therefore may rely more on call centers." Put simply, civil rights requirements can be violated either by a call center's failure to provide linguistic access or by its failure to provide timely access of any kind.

Thus far, CMS has limited its use of mitigation plans to address violations of 42 CFR 435.916. But the CAA makes its remedies available whenever a state does not "conduct eligibility redeterminations ... in accordance with **all** Federal requirements applicable to such redeterminations." CAA §5131(a)(4) (emphasis supplied). See also §5131(b) ("compliance with all Federal requirements applicable to eligibility redeterminations"). Civil rights regulations, no less than Medicaid regulations, are "Federal requirements applicable to eligibility redeterminations," and thus should be addressed by mitigation plans that bar procedural terminations until states rectify their violations of federal law.

- 3. Medicaid managed care organizations (MCOs) should be allowed to prevent procedural terminations by completing their members' renewal paperwork. CMS forbids such activities based on its reading of Social Security Act §1903(b)(4), which bars Medicaid MCOs from serving as "an enrollment broker in marketing medicaid managed care organizations ... to eligible individuals." Under 42 CFR 438.810, Medicaid enrollment brokers must be independent of MCOs when such brokers provide "enrollment services," which includes "taking enrollments by phone, in person, or through electronic means of communication." We believe that CMS should not read these provisions as barring an MCO from helping its existing beneficiaries retain Medicaid eligibility, for two reasons:
 - Such an MCO is not acting as an enrollment broker, because it is not "marketing Medicaid MCOs to eligible individuals." It is not helping a new Medicaid beneficiary or anyone else select a particular MCO. The prohibition against letting MCOs act as enrollment brokers arose out of concern for marketing abuses and conflicts of interest in guiding beneficiary plan choices. Such concerns do not apply when the beneficiary has long since chosen a particular MCO, and the MCO is seeking only to help the member retain or regain eligibility for health coverage.
 - Helping a beneficiary complete a renewal form telephonically is "taking a renewal by phone," not "taking an
 enrollment by phone." Medicaid regulations frequently distinguish between the terms, "renewal," on the one
 hand, and "enrollment" or "application," on the other. See, e.g., 42 CFR 435.908, 435.1200.

In the final moments of our call, we touched on two additional recommendations:

- 1. CMS should find that a state violates its duty, under ACA Section 1413(c)(3), to renew eligibility based on data "to the maximum extent practicable" if the state's *ex parte* renewal rates fall far below those of similarly situated states. A state's past refusal to invest in improving its eligibility systems should not be rewarded by scaling back the state's obligation to protect its eligible residents through *ex parte* renewal.
- 2. CMS should release state redetermination data as quickly as possible, including data disaggregated based on race and ethnicity, so that all stakeholders can quickly engage when problems emerge.



Subject: [EXTERNAL] Follow-up

Hi, Jessica. Great to touch base with you on Monday! Once again, thank you for taking the time to meet with us. More important, thank you for all the amazing work you and your colleagues are doing to extend health coverage and promote health equity, including recent strong statements about the impact of Speaker McCarthy's Medicaid proposals.

As promised, this note follows up some of the points we discussed on Monday.

An emerging challenge in unwinding involves beneficiaries having nowhere to go for help when problems arise.

Assistance is needed, for example, when a family gets a notice it doesn't understand, or a parent takes their child to the doctor and learns Medicaid has been terminated. If such families do not get hands-on help, procedural termination

often results. On Monday, we recommended three approaches to giving more families a place to go for help, especially in historically marginalized communities:

- 1. The Administration should maximize funding that helps community agencies provide one-on-one help. We appreciate HRSA's supplemental funding for health centers. And CCIIO's additional funding for navigators could also be helpful, if navigators can use the money to help people obtain a Medicaid eligibility determination. That role has a nexus to the Marketplace, since a person's movement from Medicaid to Marketplace requires a determination of Medicaid ineligibility, which does not happen when Medicaid ends for procedural reasons.
- 2. Mitigation plans should have states place procedural terminations on hold if families attempting telephonic renewal face prolonged call-center delays. OCR noted that, "under some circumstances," a state may violate civil rights laws by failing to "adequately fund and staff call centers to ensure they are accessible without prolonged delays." OCR explained, "Persons of color are less likely to have broadband or internet access, or transportation or jobs that permit the time and access needed to meet with Medicaid enrollment staff in person, and therefore may rely more on call centers." Put simply, civil rights requirements can be violated either by a call center's failure to provide linguistic access or by its failure to provide timely access of any kind.

Thus far, CMS has limited its use of mitigation plans to address violations of 42 CFR 435.916. But the CAA makes its remedies available whenever a state does not "conduct eligibility redeterminations ... in accordance with **all** Federal requirements applicable to such redeterminations." CAA §5131(a)(4) (emphasis supplied). See also §5131(b) ("compliance with all Federal requirements applicable to eligibility redeterminations"). Civil rights regulations, no less than Medicaid regulations, are "Federal requirements applicable to eligibility redeterminations," and thus should be addressed by mitigation plans that bar procedural terminations until states rectify their violations of federal law.

- 3. Medicaid managed care organizations (MCOs) should be allowed to prevent procedural terminations by completing their members' renewal paperwork. CMS forbids such activities based on its reading of Social Security Act §1903(b)(4), which bars Medicaid MCOs from serving as "an enrollment broker in marketing medicaid managed care organizations ... to eligible individuals." Under 42 CFR 438.810, Medicaid enrollment brokers must be independent of MCOs when such brokers provide "enrollment services," which includes "taking enrollments by phone, in person, or through electronic means of communication." We believe that CMS should not read these provisions as barring an MCO from helping its existing beneficiaries retain Medicaid eligibility, for two reasons:
 - Such an MCO is not acting as an enrollment broker, because it is not "marketing Medicaid MCOs to eligible individuals." It is not helping a new Medicaid beneficiary or anyone else select a particular MCO. The prohibition against letting MCOs act as enrollment brokers arose out of concern for marketing abuses and conflicts of interest in guiding beneficiary plan choices. Such concerns do not apply when the beneficiary has long since chosen a particular MCO, and the MCO is seeking only to help the member retain or regain eligibility for health coverage.
 - Helping a beneficiary complete a renewal form telephonically is "taking a renewal by phone," not "taking an
 enrollment by phone." Medicaid regulations frequently distinguish between the terms, "renewal," on the one
 hand, and "enrollment" or "application," on the other. See, e.g., 42 CFR 435.908, 435.1200.

In the final moments of our call, we touched on two additional recommendations:

- 1. CMS should find that a state violates its duty, under ACA Section 1413(c)(3), to renew eligibility based on data "to the maximum extent practicable" if the state's ex parte renewal rates fall far below those of similarly situated states. A state's past refusal to invest in improving its eligibility systems should not be rewarded by scaling back the state's obligation to protect its eligible residents through ex parte renewal.
- 2. CMS should release state redetermination data as quickly as possible, including data disaggregated based on race and ethnicity, so that all stakeholders can quickly engage when problems emerge.
