Please see below a summary of the information we just shared on LA. Please also see attached an informal copy of the draft health care-related tax CIB.

FMG is not aware of any disallowances recently issued or in process for Louisiana. We believe the issue relates to an active 2022 Financial Management Review (FMR) that FMG is conducting regarding whether the state claimed the 6.2 percentage point FFCRA FMAP accurately (not whether they complied with section overall section 6008 requirements). The FMR, which covered the first two quarters of calendar year 2020, is still ongoing and we have not issued a draft report to the state or finalized any potential findings.

Preliminarily, FMG staff and our contractor identified almost \$4 billion in FFP claimed that did not appear to have supporting documentation. Throughout the FMR, we have provided the state an opportunity to provide supporting documentation and they have now documented all but about \$800 million FFP. The state recently expressed some challenges with producing the remaining documentation due to its contractor. We are continuing to work with the state to obtain any remaining documentation and are not certain whether there will be a finding in this area (and if so, how much). If a disallowance is ultimately necessary on this issue, it would likely not occur until late 2023, it could be for a significantly reduced amount, and it would follow many additional opportunities for the state to demonstrate that its claims at issue were allowable.

I hope you are doing well! I am working with the American Ambulance Association (AAA), which you may recall represents ground ambulance services of various types, sizes, and geographic locations throughout the United States. I am looking for some advice and help about how to get CMS to engage with us and other stakeholders to address a Medicaid reimbursement issue.

Ambulance services are struggling to recruit and retain staff, maintain service levels, and meet the demand for their services. The industry has been hit hard by the COVID-19 pandemic, wage inflation, and the national healthcare workforce shortage.

This is leading to:

- Delayed response times to medical 911 calls;
- Hospital overcrowding due to delays in discharge and transportation to other care sites; and
- · Impaired access to care for vulnerable residents who rely on ambulance transportation.

We are working with numerous states to increase Medicaid reimbursement for ambulance providers to help them with these challenges. However, CMS is reinterpreting a definition that will reduce the amount of additional funding available to states by approximately half. Specifically, this interpretation could have an outsized impact on rural providers and transportation for patients between facilities that require medical care. The issue centers on how CMS is defining "emergency ambulance services".

We understand CMS has recently revised its interpretation of "emergency ambulance services" through verbal direction to some states. We are working to ask CMS to reconsider the definition reinterpretation and engage with industry stakeholders on this issue.

I am attaching a letter from Governors Edwards and Evers asking the Administrator to step in and help address this issue, as well as the legal memorandum they reference in their letter.

I hope that you can help us as well. I'm in the process of requesting a meeting with the Administrator, but would appreciate your assistance in helping to direct us as to the best way to solve this problem.

I hope you are doing well! I am working with the American Ambulance Association (AAA), which you may recall represents ground ambulance services of various types, sizes, and geographic locations throughout the United States. I am looking for some advice and help about how to get CMS to engage with us and other stakeholders to address a Medicaid reimbursement issue.

Ambulance services are struggling to recruit and retain staff, maintain service levels, and meet the demand for their services. The industry has been hit hard by the COVID-19 pandemic, wage inflation, and the national healthcare workforce shortage.

This is leading to:

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We are working with numerous states to increase Medicaid reimbursement for ambulance providers to help them with these challenges. However, CMS is reinterpreting a definition that will reduce the amount of additional funding available to states by approximately half. Specifically, this interpretation could have an outsized impact on rural providers and transportation for patients between facilities that require medical care. The issue centers on how CMS is defining "emergency ambulance services".

We understand CMS has recently revised its interpretation of "emergency ambulance services" through verbal direction to some states. We are working to ask CMS to reconsider the definition reinterpretation and engage with industry stakeholders on this issue.

I am attaching a letter from Governors Edwards and Evers asking the Administrator to step in and help address this issue, as well as the legal memorandum they reference in their letter. I hope that you can help us as well. I'm in the process of requesting a meeting with the Administrator, but would appreciate your assistance in helping to direct us as to the best way to solve this problem. Please see below a summary of the information we just shared on LA. Please also see attached an informal copy of the draft health care-related tax CIB.

FMG is not aware of any disallowances recently issued or in process for Louisiana. We believe the issue relates to an active 2022 Financial Management Review (FMR) that FMG is conducting regarding whether the state claimed the 6.2 percentage point FFCRA FMAP accurately (not whether they complied with section overall section 6008 requirements). The FMR, which covered the first two quarters of calendar year 2020, is still ongoing and we have not issued a draft report to the state or finalized any potential findings.

Preliminarily, FMG staff and our contractor identified almost \$4 billion in FFP claimed that did not appear to have supporting documentation. Throughout the FMR, we have provided the state an opportunity to provide supporting documentation and they have now documented all but about \$800 million FFP. The state recently expressed some challenges with producing the remaining documentation due to its contractor. We are continuing to work with the state to obtain any remaining documentation and are not certain whether there will be a finding in this area (and if so, how much). If a disallowance is ultimately necessary on this issue, it would likely not occur until late 2023, it could be for a significantly reduced amount, and it would follow many additional opportunities for the state to demonstrate that its claims at issue were allowable.

- Purpose of this subgroup: develop a bundled payment for services delivered to people who use drugs/people with substance use disorders that can be billed for in both harm reduction (e.g., SSPs) and outpatient treatment (e.g., FQHCs/CHCs) settings.
- Goal of this subgroup: Announcement from CMS on this option encouraging state
 Medicaid programs to implement; CMS could put out an Informational Bulletin
 (though this might be some time in the future given other CMS priorities right now)
 and/or we could host a webinar.
- Set of services discussed for a potential bundle:
 - Case management (to potentially include an outreach component)

- Consider secondary goals/needs re: implementation (e.g., building capacity of harm reduction programs to bill; evaluation)

Good morning Rory,

We have heard back on the FL LIP settlement discussions for OCG below. The state is offering to do the following:

- Dismiss the district court appeal on the \$97M disallowance (we have those funds)
- Pay the \$150M self-reported overpayment disallowance we recently issued with the OIG audit disallowance
- CMS forgives the \$63M FL LIP FMR disallowance
- Pay 50% of the OIG FL LIP audit on Jackson Memorial Hospital

Total from the state would amount to \$383M on the FL LIP settlement. They are also requesting more than the 12 quarters to return the funds. In Joint Clearance, Dan felt that our optimal range for settlement should be 50%-77% of the total of the disallowances. This would put us at \$291M to \$451M. Also, we provided the NY extended repayment information to DOJ and it was determined that an extended repayment plan could be part of the settlement discussions.

I think DOJ started at the 77% range. FL's counter is within our 50%-77% range, at 66% of the total. DFP's recommendation would be to accept the offer.

Please let me know the next steps. After OGD's review and determination, I assume that we would need to take the decision to Joint Clearance. If so, we are ready for the discussion with Dan.
